The checklist below is essential for any workplace that has forklifts on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural weakness which may cause injury, damage to machine or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating are of the forklift?
- 2) Is access by pedestrians to forklift areas restricted by a barrier?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs clearly visible?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Alterations or changes to the daily forklift schedule has been communicated to staff?
- 7) The forklift tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift inspection and certification done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Could the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured right?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted correctly on the forklift?
- 19) Do the operators of the lift truck have certifications to utilize the equipment?
- 20) Are warning signs and speed limits being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their duties to report the damage to the equipment and other lift truck accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
